Student Dress and Behavior Guidelines

Valuables

Please do not bring any valuables to graduation. There will be no place to store anything during the ceremony. Cell phones and/or keys will be left in a secure place during the ceremony. Leave any and all items that you carry with you ELSEWHERE!

Female Attire

All will wear a nice dress or top and skirt (NO pants) under the academic gowns. If your dress or skirt is a thin or sheer material, please wear a slip

Low heeled (2 inch or below) black or nude shoes or flats are required for safety reasons.

No flip flops, house shoes (slippers), or athletic shoes will be allowed.

Male Attire

All will wear a white button up dress shirt and black dress pants. No jeans.

Pants need to be pressed (free of wrinkles).

An appropriate tie is required.

No jeans, shorts, or T-shirts of any type will be allowed.

All will wear dress shoes with socks that coordinate with their attire.

No athletic shoes, no flip flops, no sandals and no house shoes (slippers) will be allowed.

Cap and Gown

Sizes do get mixed up. Be sure you try on both the Cap and Gown as soon as possible. The cap will be worn with the top of the cap as flat as possible, - NOT at an angle.

The gown will need to be pressed (free of wrinkles) and neat. Caution: Use an iron with very, very low heat or a steamer

The tassel will be worn on the right side of the head and moved to the left when announced after all graduates have crossed the stage.

Conduct

All graduates will be required to be in the staging area no later than 5:00 p.m. Arrive early to allow time to park. After 5:15 no one will be admitted to the line of march. There will be no paraphernalia allowed that will distract or disrupt the ceremony. Students that have disruptive items may be removed from the line. Caps with writing or decoration on them will be confiscated during the line-up and will not be returned. All students WILL act in a dignified manner before, during, and after the ceremony. NO CHEWING GUM!!
