	I understand that no more than one person from an immediate family can serve on the board at one time. I understand that all board members must undergo annual training in the Code of Governmental Ethics: both online and in local board training.		
	understand that all board members must annually file a financial statement in accordance with Louisiana law (a imple statement that you have filed a tax return for the previous year). understand the board of directors receives no salary and neither they nor their family members can gain ersonally by board membership.		
	I understand that the members of the board of directors are prohibited from being employed by the school while a board member and for a total of two years after resigning from the board.		
	I understand that there is much work behind the scenes and I will be asked to serve on at least one committee.		
. ,	e <u>Louisiana Charter School Board Legal Handbook</u> states that charter school boards have three basic fiduciary <u>legal</u> duties): duty of care, duty of loyalty, and duty of obedience.		
	(A) <u>Duty of Care</u> – "exercising sound, legal, and ethical board best practices and acting on an informed basis." The first example of this duty given in the handbook is "being an active Board member and participant".		
	Questions: Do you have adequate time for regular meetings, special called meetings, committee meetings, the occasional social event, and/or school function(s) attendance. What kind of autonomy do you have over your calendar?		
	(B) <u>Duty of Loyalty</u> – "giving undivided allegiance when making decisions affecting your school". Two examples of this duty given in the handbook are "never using school information for personal gain" and "avoiding conflicts of interest".		
	Questions: Are you prepared to live out a standard of faithfulness to the school and its mission/vision on a daily basis? (In public, in private, on social media, in board meetings, and elsewhere as board membership is a privilege of being a public servant of the school) If you answer "yes", explain what this loyalty means to you.		

(C) <u>Duty of Obedience</u> – "acting in furtherance of the law and the school's goals and mission". Two examples from the handbook are "acting on congruence with the Board's purpose, articles of incorporation, and bylaws" and "being mission aligned so that your actions are consistent with the school's goals, vision, and mission."
